## **BREAKFAST FOR THE HAVEN**

The Haven, 1565 Cedar Street, supports an overflow of boys, ages 13-17 from the Kent County Juvenile Detention Center. These boys are going through the court system because of charges ranging from misdemeanors to felonies. There could up to 20 boys at the Haven at any one time.

The stay for these boys is anywhere from 25 days to 5 months. Monday through Friday, lunch and dinner is cooked by a full-time employee, Meredith Nichols. Breakfast during the week is cold cereal, toast and fresh fruit. Lunch and dinner on the weekends is from the leftovers from during the week.

Breakfast on Saturday and Sundays is where the K of C gets involved by cooking a hot breakfast for the boys and guards. Bishop Haas Council cooks the breakfast the first Saturday of each month, which is 12 times a year.

What's involved? You do not have to be a chef or a cook. If you can heat ready made sausage, hash browns and scrambled eggs, you are an expert. Some cook pancakes and French toast as well. You start about 7:00 am and can be out of there by 8:30 am. All of the clean-up is done by the boys. Serving is done by the counselors.

How easy is that? This can be done by one Knight, but two is more fun. Get a friend and volunteer to help a troubled teen with life.
