





For the third straight year, our council collaborated with St. John Vianney school in conducting the 2020 Knights of Columbus Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest, This collaboration has grown strong enough to endure even the COVID pandemic, and helped to provide a semblance of normal to the students, staff, and our Council. This year's theme was all too fitting for the these cogent events the past 12 months. The students were asked to write their essay on how trusting in God during a difficult time has helped you or someone you know find the strength and hope to endure it. The teachers redeveloped this idea for grade level perspicuity. It goes without saying that events this past year made this theme personally relatable to even the youngest students in Kindergarten. The student essays were scored by members of our council based on content, grammar, and style. Certificates for First, Second, and Third place were given to the top essays for each grade. The First place for each grade also received a \$25 gift certificate to Barnes and Noble in recognition for the scholarly achievement. The winners were announced during a school wide virtual assembly on the Monday of Catholic Schools Week (February 1). During this assembly, the winners were able to share their essay with \$\mathbb{G}\$ the entire school. In a short period, this essay contest has become crucial to our council as it affirms our to service to our local school and community and helps to strengthen these relationships. It also has become important to the students and staff. Once again, the essays were integrated into the schools curriculum. To the students, this is not merely achallenge to win an award, but a scholastic achievement and letter grade. We greatly appreciate the teachers and staff, in particular, Mrs. Tessmer and Principal Olejnik, for allowing us to do this essay contest at St. John Vianney. 
